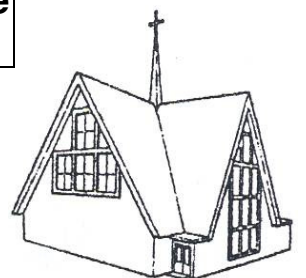
**Church Working Party May Bank Holiday
