Collect & Readings 27th July 2025

Creator God, you made us all in your image: may we discern you in all that we see, and serve you in all that we do; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Acts 16:6-16 NIV-UK

⁶ Paul and his companions travelled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia. ⁷ When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to. ⁸ So they passed by Mysia and went down to Troas. ⁹ During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, 'Come over to Macedonia and help us.' ¹⁰ After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them.

¹¹ From Troas we put out to sea and sailed straight for Samothrace, and the next day we went on to Neapolis. ¹² From there we travelled to Philippi, a Roman colony and the leading city of that district of Macedonia. And we stayed there several days.

¹³ On the Sabbath we went outside the city gate to the river, where we expected to find a place of prayer. We sat down and began to speak to the women who had gathered there. ¹⁴ One of those listening was a woman from the city of Thyatira named Lydia, a dealer in purple cloth. She was a worshipper of God. The Lord opened her heart to respond to Paul's message. ¹⁵ When she and the members of her household were baptised, she invited us to her home. 'If you consider me a believer in the Lord,' she said, 'come and stay at my house.' And she persuaded us.

¹⁶ Once when we were going to the place of prayer, we were met by a female slave who had a spirit by which she predicted the future. She earned a great deal of money for her owners by fortune-telling.

4 Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. ² After fasting for forty days and forty nights, he was hungry. ³ The tempter came to him and said, 'If you are the Son of God, tell these stones to become bread.'

All Welcome. *CHS - Church of the Holy Last Sunday I told the story of my mother's experience of being rescued from a crocodile infested river in Zambia as a powerful picture of baptism. Paul talks of us dying with Christ & rising with him to new life. Baptism is rich in symbolism - it reminds us of the Israelites crossing the red sea. Jesus spoke of being born of water and the spirit, and water is also for washing and cleansing.

It was so exciting to hear of the 92 people baptised on the beach at Bournemouth recently. One of them Liam, said how Jesus had set him free from addictions to drugs and alcohol. The rescue Jesus achieved for us on the cross truly sets us free.

We tend to think of baptism in terms of the promises we make (for ourselves or on behalf of a baby). But in reality it is much more about what Jesus has already done!

The heart of the gospel is very stark and simple. It's good news of a rescue. My mother could not save herself, she needed a rescuer. So do we! Wiliam
