

Clocks go back next week on Sunday 26th October.

If someone came to you and said 'Who is Jesus?', what would you answer? We know He is the name above all names, but there are so many names of Jesus in the Bible that we sometimes lose sight of who He is to us. The Nicene Creed gives us a language not just of what we share as belief, but some really helpful words to help us grasp afresh who He is. The wonderful phrasing of the creedal belief: "One Lord, Jesus Christ, the only son of God, eternally begotten of the Father" shows us that Jesus is Revealed - the image of the invisible God, the one in whom the creator reveals himself, and reminds us that God speaks to us through his son. He is the Reflector of God's glory - because God's fullness dwells in Him, and whoever has seen the Son has seen the Father. He is the exact imprint of God's very being. He is the Reconciler - the one who built the bridge to repair the chasm we have made between us and God through our sin. This bridge is the way, the path back to a right relationship with God. It is a bridge made from his body and his blood, poured out for us. And, Jesus is the one who Reigns - He is the one Lord, the one who sits at the right hand of the Father - the one who reigns above it all, and the one whose kingdom we are entrusted to help build here on earth until He comes again. For so many of the earthly Kings and Queens whose rule has been marred by disaster, evil or ruin, Jesus is the true King - the one who reigns eternally. He is supreme over all creation, and the head of the body - His church. Just take a moment to ponder afresh who Jesus is, why He came into the world for us, and what his Kingship might look like - then praise Him for all he was, is and is to come. Blessings, Rev James
