

Eternal Lord, our beginning and our end: bring us with the whole creation to your glory, hidden through past ages and made known in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Philippians 1:27-2:4 NIV-UK

²⁷ Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel ²⁸ without being frightened in any way by those who oppose you. This is a sign to them that they will be destroyed, but that you will be saved – and that by God. ²⁹ For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him, ³⁰ since you are going through the same struggle you saw I had, and now hear that I still have.

2 Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, ² then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. ³ Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

In 1964, a clergyman and missionary, James Seddon, who was rooted in his passion for global mission, penned the words to a hymn we know today as 'Go forth and tell! O Church of God awake!' His words, which speak of going to where darkness still lies and of doors that are open wide were inspired by Jesus' Great Commission to His disciples, before His Ascension into Heaven, to spread the Good News to all the Earth.

As Christians, we, too, are called to be messengers of the Gospel; a Gospel of good news of Light coming into our darkened world; joy, peace; sacrificial love; forgiveness and hope of an eternal life to come.

We know how much we can be encouraged at receiving good news from family or friends – news of the passing of an exam or driving test or a new addition to the family; or job promotion. God provides us with opportunities to share His Good News – maybe a personal testimony; or explaining to someone the reason for the hope we have; sharing a piece of scripture we have found helpful; or through kind actions.

In proclaiming the Gospel, we can draw on the strength and wisdom of God's Holy Spirit, which guides us to speak with truth and boldness. As the body of Christ, we are called into an active partnership as 'Gospel Proclaimers', along with our brothers and sisters in Christ across the world.
