

## Collect & Readings 25<sup>th</sup> January 2026

God of all mercy, your Son proclaimed good news to the poor, release to the captives, and freedom to the oppressed: anoint us with your Holy Spirit and set all your people free to praise you in Christ our Lord.

### Philippians 2:5-30 NIV - UK

<sup>5</sup> In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: <sup>6</sup> who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; <sup>7</sup> rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death – even death on a cross! <sup>9</sup> Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, <sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. <sup>12</sup> Therefore, my dear friends, as you have always obeyed – not only in my presence, but now much more in my absence – continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, <sup>13</sup> for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfil his good purpose. <sup>14</sup> Do everything without grumbling or arguing, <sup>15</sup> so that you may become blameless and pure, 'children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation.' Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky <sup>16</sup> as you hold firmly to the word of life. And then I will be able to boast on the day of Christ that I did not run or labour in vain. <sup>17</sup> But even if I am being poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you. <sup>18</sup> So you too should be glad and rejoice with me. <sup>19</sup> I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you soon, that I also may be cheered when I receive news about you. <sup>20</sup> I have no one else like him, who will show genuine concern for your welfare. <sup>21</sup> For everyone looks out for their own interests, not those of Jesus Christ. <sup>22</sup> But you know that Timothy has proved himself, because as a son with his father he has served with me in the work of the gospel. <sup>23</sup> I hope, therefore, to send him as soon as I see how things go with me. <sup>24</sup> And I am confident in the Lord that I myself will come soon. <sup>25</sup> But I think it is necessary to send back to you Epaphroditus, my brother, co-worker and fellow soldier, who is also your messenger, whom you sent to take care of my needs. <sup>26</sup> For he longs for all of you and is distressed because you heard he was ill. <sup>27</sup> Indeed he was ill, and almost died. But God had mercy on him, and not on him only but also on me, to spare me sorrow upon sorrow. <sup>28</sup> Therefore I am all the more eager to send him, so that when you see him again you may be glad and I may have less anxiety. <sup>29</sup> So then, welcome him in the Lord with great joy, and honour people like him, <sup>30</sup> because he almost died for the work of Christ. He risked his life to make up for the help you yourselves could not give me.

"Believe in yourself." "Kickstart growth." "Take back our streets." These are all familiar slogans that people in the media and in political debates trot out. In Paul's day, in the first century Roman empire, Caesar also had his slogans, as empires always do. "Caesar is Lord - and saviour," was one. Another was, "There is no other name under heaven by which we can be saved, but Caesar."

So for Paul, or any Christian to say "Jesus is Lord", or for Peter to say (in Acts 4), "there is no other name under heaven by which we can be saved, but Jesus," was profoundly subversive. In Paul's letter to the Philippians, "Live as citizens worthy of the gospel" (1.27) was a challenge about allegiance. Philippi was a Roman colony fiercely loyal to Rome and to Caesar (Nero), so for them to be firm in their allegiance to Christ was likely to be contested and costly.

Nearly 5000 Christians were murdered for their faith in 2025. We see the protests in Iran in the face of a brutal crackdown, and yet Iran is the fastest growing church in the world! We do not face that kind of pressure and persecution here in the West. But where do we need to hold our nerve in the face of opposition? What gospel issues do we face in Burpham? How can we remain bold in our witness and true to Jesus Christ? Where is your allegiance? Blessings, William
